

Meeting of the Commission - Granada, 1st May, 1992

1. Roll call of Delegates and Opening of the Meeting

31 Federations were represented, including 9 by written proxy.

The FIP President, D.N. Jatia, greeted the delegates and expressed his congratulations to the Commission for the serious and efficient job done. He especially appreciated the work done for the preparation of the SREV and the Guidelines.

2. Approval of the Minutes of London Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held in London on May 11th, 1991, were unanimously approved.

3. Report of the President

In addition to his written report circulated to the delegates, Dr. Morolli informed about the seminar for judges and exhibitor held on request of the Spanish thematic Commission and the O.C. of Granada '92. More than 50 participants attended the meeting devoted to the presentation of the results of the exhibition with the analysis of the areas for improvement.

4. SREV and Guidelines

The final draft of these documents was presented and the bureau charged to review the text circulated.

5. Genova '92

The plans for "GENOVA '92" were presented and the meeting of the Bureau and of the Commission agreed. The Commission will discuss the plans for the coming term.

Delegates were invited to cooperate for the success of the Thematic Meeting on September 26th, devoted to the national thematic associations.

6. Elections of the President and Bureau

Dr. Giancarlo Morolli of Italy was designated as president of the Commission for the next term. Gunnar Dahlvig (Sweden), Nestor Ferré (Argentina), Jose Antonio Hernan Seijas (Spain), Bernard Jimenez (France) and Franceska Rapkin (Great Britain) were elected as Bureau members.

The President asked Mrs. Betty van Tenac and Dr. Manfred Bergam to cooperate with the Bureau of the Commission.

Meeting of the Bureau - Granada, 1st May, 1992

The Bureau elected Gunnar Dahlvig as Vice President and Bernard Jimenez as Secretary of the Commission.

The Bureau members, with some invited delegates review thoroughly the text of the SREV and the Guidelines and charged Mrs. Rapkin to take care of the final "polish" of the Guidelines.
